## Online Service Request for a Search of Records

The Historical Group maintains a copy of all Baptisms, Confirmations, Marriages, Burials and Interments that have been carried out at St. George's Church since its consecration in 1848. With the exception of current records however, all original records are held securely in the Mortlock Wing of the State Library of South Australia, in Adelaide.

Embargoes apply to all records if you are making an enquiry about another person. Refer to each section for the relevant embargo period.

No copies of records will be issued before the search fee of \$25.00 is paid.

*Please note that early records do not give the same amount of information as is now required for a baptism, marriage or burial/interment.* Download this form, fill in appropriate section and either post it or email it to us at the address at the end of the form.
