Associate Minister Update

On Thursday 2nd August, Parish Council met and considered the question of the Associate Minister. A motion was passed ‘to approve an expression of interest for a full time associate minister, who may or may not be ordained, at remuneration appropriate to their qualifications’.

In discussions, Parish Council were very supportive of spending the roughly \$67000 p.a. that would correspond to an unordained person, at an award rate. However, the larger amount required to pay an ordained associate was left for further discussion at the next meeting.
