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### **Job Description and Person Specification**

#### **Title of Job: Associate Minister with Responsibility for Youth and Mission**

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**Tenure: Full time. Reports to: Rector. Diocese: Anglican Diocese of Adelaide.**

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##### *A. Context for Position*

St. Georges was the first Anglican Church consecrated in the Colony of South Australia (1848). It currently has two services on a Sunday, an 8:30 traditional service and a 10:15 contemporary family service.

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##### *B. St. Georges Mission Statement*

To present everyone mature in Christ and to present Christ to everyone. (from Colossians 1:28)

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##### *C. Our Beliefs*

Our beliefs are summarised in the 39 Articles of Religion, and worked out in the principles and theology of the Book of Common Prayer. As an Anglican reformed, evangelical church, we affirm the truths laid out in the Nicene, Apostles, and Athanasian Creeds. The Parish Council also works to ensure Parish ministries align with the Jerusalem Declaration.

At the centre of our beliefs lies the Bible as our ultimate authority, and the saving work of Jesus Christ on the cross as our only means of salvation.

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##### *D. Duties and Responsibilities*

###### 1. Preaching and Teaching

a) Faithful proclamation of the gospel through biblical, Christ centred preaching and teaching. Approximately once a month preaching.

b) Overseeing, developing and growing the Friday Youth Group (school years 7-12) and Sunday Youth Church (school years 6-8) ministries.

c) Encourage a passion for sharing the gospel with those who are not in a relationship with God.

d) Planning periodic evangelistic services, and outreach events to the local area, including running and advertising periodically an evangelistic course for enquirers.

###### 2. Leadership

a) Recruiting and Leading teams, including the Youth Group, Youth church and Mission team.

b) Identifying, planning and implementing new ministries in line with the Mission Statement.

c) Identifying, equipping, training and supporting leaders of key ministry areas.

d) Strategic planning, and implementing of evangelistic strategies.

### 3. Partnerships

a) Ensure continued positive engagement within the Diocese of Adelaide, in particular in youth ministry camps and other youth-related cooperative ventures.

b) Lead in the Parish's interaction with Missionaries, through our partner organisations, CMS, BCA and AFES
