### Coronavirus (COVID-19) implications for church

There are a number of different reputable sources discouraging shaking hands, and so we will no longer be shaking hands at the door of church, nor as part of church. We have ordered new communion glasses, expecting the popularity of the common cup to decline. Intinction (dipping the wafer in the wine) is discouraged for health reasons. Can I encourage those administering communion as well as those setting up morning tea, to be especially vigilant in washing their hands, and using alcohol-based hand sanitizer as they prepare. It will be a challenge adjusting to this new order of things, but we do so aiming to serve others, as Christ has served us.
